You were previously notified that the Trenton Public Schools would be closed until March 27th. However, recently, Governor Phil Murphy issued an Executive Order closing schools indefinitely. In compliance with the directive, the Trenton Public Schools will be closed until further notice.

Be advised that our food service operations will continue. Grab and Go, Breakfast and Lunch meals, can be picked up daily from Mott Elementary, Joyce Kilmer School, Martin Luther King Elementary and Trenton Central High Schools between the hours of 11:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. We plan to expand our locations starting the week of March 30, 2020.

Due to school closures, we must continue our transition to virtual learning. We want to commend our students for continuing their educational learning via lessons provided through Google Classrooms. Data shows that many of our students are taking advantage of our digital platforms and taking their learning seriously. Teachers and staff will continue providing new lessons and resources through the District's website and our other digital platforms. I want to also commend our teachers and staff for their lessons and interactions with our students. We see your great work!
